**S.S. 3-6 PALEOHORI**

**Length:** 12,43 km

Stage closes at: 09:30

**(Stage will remain closed after S.S.3)**

**Description:** The first, quite uphill section of the stage is followed by a very rough part towards the well known and very spectacular Lake of Eleftherochori. A very popular destination for the locals which, nevertheless, requires arriving very early and also staying at this spot until the end of both passages. After the Lake, the stage becomes narrow but quite fast until the end before Eleftherochori village.

#### **ACCESS TO SPECTATORS**

**1**

Following the National Road Athens- Lamia, at Thermopyles junction, turn left if you are coming from Athens or right if you are coming from Lamia, and head towards Bralos. In 19,15 km, at Bralos junction, turn left towards Palaiochori. At the church reset your odometer. After 2,52 km, and while driving through Palaiochori village, at the junction with a closed tavern on the right and an Electrical Power Station on the left, turn left towards Kalidromo - Palaiochori Lake. After an additional 1,61 km, you will reach the 2,08 km of the S.S.

**ATTENTION:** The road serves as ambulance escape route. Mind NOT to park in a way that obstructs traffic.

Following the National Road Athens-Lamia, at Thermopyles junction, turn left if you are coming from Athens or right if you are coming from Lamia, and head towards Bralos. In 15,15 km, at the junction do not turn right towards Skamno – Pavliani – Mavrolithari, but keep driving straight. Follow the road book and after 2,23 km head right and cross the bridge. After an additional 4,20 km, you will reach the 5,96 km of the S.S.

**ATTENTION:** Access is suitable ONLY for offroad 4x4 vehicles and enduro motorbikes.
