



**SUNDAY 8 MAY 2016**

**S.S. 7-10 EKO RACING ELEFTHEROHORI**

**Lenght:** 17,87 km

Stage closes at: 06:30

1st Car Timetable SS7: 08:55

1st Car Timetable SS10: 13:06

**(Stage will remain closed after S.S.7)**

**Description:** The stage starts with the last part of Day 1 final stage (Palaiochori) but in the opposite direction and at the lake continues left towards Mendenitsa. After the lake, it enters the forest with a rough part of nearly 4 km and passes by the big lake. It ends with a narrow downhill section above Mendenitsa village.

#### **ACCESS TO SPECTATORS**

##### **1**

Following the National Road Athens- Lamia, at Thermopyles junction, turn left if you are coming from Athens or right if you are coming from Lamia, and head towards Bralos. In 19,15 km, at Bralos junction, turn left towards Palaiochori. At the church reset your odometer. After 2,52 km, and while driving through Palaiochori village, at the junction with a closed tavern on the right and an Electrical Power Station on the left, turn left towards "Kalidromo - Palaiochori Lake". Drive through the village and after an additional 6,98 km follow the road book and you will reach the 3,94 km of the stage. The road surface in the last 5,37 km of the access may be damaged from the passage of rally cars during the previous day.

**ATTENTION:** The road serves as ambulance escape route. Mind NOT to park in a way that obstructs traffic.

On the old National Road Athens – Lamia, coming from Thermopyles or Kamena Bourla, reset your odometer at the exit sign towards Anavra. Follow the road book and after 14,33 km you will reach a junction where:

**A**

Either you keep straight in order to reach the 12,77 km of the stage,

**B**

Or turn left in order to reach the 12,95 km of the stage.
