E.Δ. 9-12 ELATIA/KARYA

Length: 33,86 km

Stage closes at: 08:45

(Stage will remain closed after S.S.9)

Description: The longest and most difficult stage of the rally. It starts with 10 km uphill and brings joy to both drivers and spectators. Then, and just before Zeli village, it continues left and after about 5 km it reaches the Profitis Ilias monastery with a very spectacular jump. In the following 12 km, R5 rally cars are expected to overrule their N4 competitors. The last 7,50 km are pretty slow with continuous, and very challenging for the drivers, tight turns.

ACCESS TO SPECTATORS

1

At the exit of Elati village heading towards Atalanti, at the Ravoil gas-station, reset your odometer. After 780 meters, turn left on the gravel road and follow the road book. After 2,68 km, you will reach the start of the stage with a big parking area.

2

Heading from Livadia towards Atalanti, at the junction where to the left leads to Elatia and to the right to Sfaka, keep straight for 5,19 km. At the following junction turn left towards Kalapodi and reset your odometer. Follow the road book and you will reach the 10,45 km of the stage.

If you are coming from Elatia, after the Revoil gas-station at the village exit, there is a junction where straight leads to Sfaka , right to Livadia and left to Kalapodi-Atalanti. Turn left and after 5,19

km, at the next junction, turn left towards Kalapodi and reset your odometer. Follow the road book and you will reach the 10,45 km of the stage.

ATTENTION: The road serves as ambulance escape route. Mind NOT to park in a way that obstructs traffic.

BLOCKING THE AMBULANCE ESCAPE ROUTE MAY CAUSE THE CANCELLATION OF THE SPECIAL STAGE

If you enter the stage **BEFORE THE CLOSING TIME (08:45)** and drive up to the 21,88 km, you will find a road that after 1,13 km will lead you to the 5,33 km. of S.S. 8-11 SEAJETS Rengini.

ATTENTION: You will be able to leave from this access only after the end of the second run of the stage.
