## S.S. 4-7 Drossohori

### GPS

Start: N-38.34.065 E-22.26.260 / ALT: 583

Finish: N-38.38.401 E-22.26.998 / ALT: 878

**Description:** The well-known Drossohori stage will run this year in its old direction. It is a fast gravel hillclimb in the first 15,6 km, before entering the beautiful fir forest of Pamassos mountain for another 9,5 kilometers, descending to its finish line. Its surface is of great quality at the first part but a bit rough at the second, but the stage displays and a wide range of turns throughout its length.

### ACCESS ROADS

**1>** Coming from the Athens-Lamia Highway, exit right to Bralos-Amfissa junction. In 26,52 km, at the first entrance to the village of Gravia, keep straight. After 29,73 km you will arrive at the junction to Drossohori-Elaionas - turn left and reset your odometer.

**2>** Coming from the Athens-Lamia Highway, exit right to Bralos-Amfissa junction. In 26,52 km, at the first entrance to the village of Gravia, turn left. After 1,86 km (see a supermarket on you left-hand side) turn left towards Mariolata-Lilaia. Right after exiting the village of Lilaia, turn right at the junction towards Eptalofos. After 9,77 km reset your odometer, heading straight to Pamassos Ski Resort.

**3>** Follow the same directions as in A.R.2, reset your odometer and follow the road book of Access Road 3.

**ATTENTION:** Access roads 2 and 3 of the Drossohori SS serve as ambulance escape routes. Mind NOT to park in a way that obstructs traffic. [Blocking the ambulance escape route may cause cancellation of the Special Stage]
